How time fly's it has been seven years since we last held our quadrennial congress in Croatia. Covid-19 delayed our initial plans for Darwin but we are back on track for Darwin 2025. An important part of this meeting will be deciding on the location for the 2029 congress.

The World Federation of Neuroscience Nurses (WFNN) was established in 1969 and is the only international neuroscience nursing organization dedicated to the promotion and development of neuroscience nursing worldwide. We have a long history of successful event with the congress more recently held in Opatija, Croatia (2017 with 452 attendees); Gifu, Japan (2013 with 681 attendees); Toronto, Canada (2009 with 250 attendees); Barcelona, Spain (2005 with 351 attendees); and the first time ever in the Southern Hemisphere - Sydney, Australia (2001 with 320 attendees).

The congress provides you with a platform to showcase your country and member organisation. It is an opportunity to host an amazing event that showcases both outstanding, and emerging neuroscience nurse leaders.

Successful bids will be supported by the WFNN team in planning and delivering the 2029 congress.

We look forward to discussing this opportunity further with any member organisations considering submitting a bid.
